With 50 mm of pressure to the calf, when the calf is compressed all of the blood in the calf is forced into the thigh and out to the heart through the vena cava. The compression therapy mimics the body's natural muscle contractions to increase venous blood flow to the body's lower extremities. The devices have a battery lasting up to 24 hours, a cordless design, simple one button operation and comfortable and adjustable sleeves. The "R" device is a removal device ideal for multi-patient use in a hospital like setting where the standard model is single patient use ideal for the home setting.

Devon MD is also expanding markets into Negative Pressure Wound Therapy (NPWT) with both a portable and clinical setting pump as well as a full line of dressings. Another market Devon MD sets to expand into is compression therapy for Lymphedema.
